We are thrilled to share with you some of the amazing activities that have been conducted for our Primary 5 and Primary 6 students recently. In this issue, we are highlighting 3 memorable events that our Upper Primary students were part of in Term 3.

The P5 students attended the NE show that took place in Week 2. They also had the chance to participate in the SwimSafer programme to equip themselves with the essential swimming skills.

To get our Primary 6 students ready for PSLE, we have organised the P6 Motivational Day that aims to encourage them in their preparation for PSLE and helped them in goal setting.

1. Primary 5 NE Show

On 8th July 2023, our Primary 5 students were fortunate enough to watch the NE show that was happening on the Padang for the first time since 2019. The theme for this year's national day parade is "Onward As One" where Singaporeans were called upon to look forward confidently and move onwards together in building our shared future as one united people.





The students were audience to a spectacular show of fireworks, military mobile columns and a nostalgic session of community sing-along for new and old NDP songs. Our nation's rich

story and history was also presented in a breath-taking series of performances. This allows our Primary 5 students to understand how Singapore has come thus far.
